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NATIONAL BROILER MARKET AT-A-GLANCE



Whole broiler fryer prices are trending steady to barely steady in the Midwest, fully steady to barely steady in the West, and steady in the East. Preliminary majority prices are unchanged in all areas when compared to early week prices. Offerings of all sizes are light to heavy, mostly light to moderate. Retail and food service demand is light to moderate entering the weekend. Floor stocks are light to moderate. The market activity is mostly moderate. In the parts structure, movement is moderate to good for late week business. Prices continue to trend firm to higher for whole breast and tenders, steady to firm for dark meat items, and steady for wings. Offerings are light for bone-in breast and tenders, light to moderate for dark meat, and moderate for wings. Market activity is moderate to active. In production areas, live supplies are moderate for mixed, but mostly desirable weights.

NORTHEAST BROILER/FRYER Prices are trending generally steady for most sizes. Trucklot buying activity for ready-to-cook whole broiler fryers is light to moderate entering the weekend. Offerings are moderate to heavy with the three pound and heavier sizes noted as slightly more available. Trade activity is light to moderate. In the parts complex, supplies of tenders, thighs and thigh meat are light and clearing satisfactorily. The balance of items are light to moderate.

MIDWEST BROILER/FRYER Preliminary prices were 1 to 2 cents lower than last Monday's majority into Chicago. Whole bird prices are barely steady to steady. Whole bird offerings are light to mostly moderate. Demand into retail outlets is light to moderate, while food service demand was light with fast food demand as normal to at times good. Weights are desirable to light. Market activity on whole birds is light to moderate at best. Parts prices are mixed with bone in breasts, jumbo wings and leg items steady and barely steady on small wings and boneless breast. Supplies of all parts are balanced for current needs. Buyer demand is light to moderate for all parts items. Market activity is moderate for parts with leg items and jumbo wings receiving the most interest.

WESTERN BROILER/FRYER The Los Angeles preliminary majority is 95 cents, unchanged from last Monday's final. The market on whole broiler/fryers is steady, WOGs mixed ranging from barely steady to fully steady. Offerings light on 3 lb. and heavier weights and light to moderate on under 3 lb. sizes. Retail and foodservice demand light to good, mostly light to moderate. Floor stocks moderate. Weights desirable. The market on bone-in breasts and tenderloins is steady to firm with higher offering prices reported, boneless skinless breasts and wings steady to fully steady. The market on dark items is steady to firm with boneless items in the strongest position. Domestic demand light to good, mostly light to moderate. Offerings of wings and boneless skinless breasts are light to moderate; tenderloins and bone-in breasts very light to light and held with confidence. Offerings of dark items are very light to instances moderate. Movement light to good, mostly light to moderate.

SOUTHERN BROILER/FRYER Prices are steady for whole broiler/fryers. Offerings are light to moderate for current trade needs. Demand is moderate entering the weekend. Market activity is moderate. In the parts structure, movement is moderate to good for late week trading. Prices for whole breast and tenders are firm to higher, wings are mixed with jumbo wings in the strongest position, and dark meat items are steady to firm. Offerings for parts are light to moderate with whole breast, tenders, and drums light and moving well. All other parts are moderate. The market activity for parts is moderate to active. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at mixed, but mostly desirable weights.

DELMARVA BROILER/FRYERS Less-than-trucklot asking prices are unchanged at 80 to 90 cents, with a steady trending undertone. Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds is moderate entering the weekend. Offerings are moderate for current trade needs. Live supplies are moderate; weights are mixed, but noted as mostly desirable. Processor schedules are moderately heavy. Market activity is moderate. In the parts complex, supplies are light to moderate and moving satisfactorily.
