Whole broiler/fryer prices are lower throughout the Midwest. Trade sentiment was barely steady to weak. Whole bird offers are moderate. Floor stocks are light to moderate; weights desirable. Demand is the light to moderate for both retail and food service outlets, fast food is normal to good. Whole bird market activity is mostly light. Parts prices are steady on wings and breast items, fully steady on leg items. Supplies of all parts items are light to moderate. Demand is light to moderate for all parts.
