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United States Regional Broiler & Turkey Exports

Overall exports on broiler meat were unchanged and turkey meat exports up 47% for January, 2011. For January, 2011 North America and East Asia, the top 2 United States (U.S.) broiler meat export destinations by region, equaled about 45% of total broiler meat exports. The top 2 U.S. turkey export destinations by region, North America and East Asia, for January, 2011 received about 81% of the U.S.'s total turkey exports.

Frozen leg quarters, the number 1 item exported in January and 46% of total broiler meat exports, was down 15% from January, 2010. Fresh/chilled turkey cuts, the number 1 turkey item exported in January and 35% of total exports, was up 52% from January, 2010.






January 2011 Broiler Meat Exports By Region And Volume

MSC prices trended firm to higher on all fat contents. Supplies were light to moderate. Schedules were irregular, but mostly normal. Demand into domestic channels was moderate to good with best interest noted on fresh 15-20%. Export demand was moderate to good. Good interest continues on frozen 15-20%, however there has been little trade activity as product availability remains limited. Market activity was moderate to active. The spot marketplace remains strong and many packers continue to stay out front 1- 2 weeks on MSC sales. Supplies of raw materials are tight. Frame values were firm with limited trading occurring between 10-13.5 cents FOB, mostly 11-12 FOB.



