



National Egg Review

This week New York prices are higher for all sizes. Early in the week, regional prices increased for the larger sizes and were mostly steady for mediums. Next week's regional asking prices are trending higher for both the heavier and lighter weight eggs. The undertone ranges steady to firm. Retail demand is light to moderate in the Northeast region with the balance of regions reporting moderate to fairly good. Food service demand is light to moderate. Offerings are light to moderate for the larger sizes and moderate to instances heavy for medium. Market activity is moderate. Breaking stock prices are steady to higher with checks and undergrades higher. The undertone is steady. Demand is moderate to instances good. Offerings are light. Supplies are light to moderate. Market activity is slow to moderate. North Central regional light type hen removal costs are unchanged. Offers are light for the moderate to fairly good demand. Schedules are mixed, full-time to part-time. Market activity is moderate.

WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 30-Jul-11 is estimated at 157.1 million head. This compares to 158.0 million head the previous week and to 163.8 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 168.7 million head and the composite weighted average price was 85.38 cents per pound.
