## NATIONAL BROILER MARKET AT-A-GLANCE



Whole broiler/fryer prices are steady in all areas. Preliminary majority prices are unchanged when compared to early week prices. Offerings of all sizes are light to moderate for trade needs. Retail demand is light to instances good with improvement noted entering the weekend. Food service demand is light to moderate. Floor stocks are light to moderate. Market activity is slow to moderate. In the parts structure, movement is light to moderate for late week business. Prices are steady to instances firm for wings, steady for most dark meat items, and weak to lower for bone-in breast, thighs and thigh meat items. Offerings are moderate for wings. Bone-in breast and thighs are heavy and slow to clear. Dark meat is mostly moderate. Market activity for parts is slow to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate. Weights are mixed, but noted are mostly desirable.

**MIDWEST BROILER/FRYER** Preliminary majority prices were unchanged in Chicago. Whole bird prices are mostly steady. Offerings are light to moderate, buyer's interest is light to moderate at best. Demand for both retail and food service is light to moderate, fast food demand is moderate. Floor stocks are light to moderate. Weights are desirable to instances light. Whole bird market activity is light to moderate. Parts prices are steady for wings and barely steady for dark meat cuts and breast items. Supplies are moderate for breast items and leg items, light for wings. Demand is light to moderate for all parts items. Market activity for parts is moderate for wings and slow to moderate for the balance of the parts.

**NORTHEAST BROILER/FRYER** Prices are trending steady for most sizes. Trucklot buying activity for ready-to-cook whole broiler fryers is moderate entering the weekend. Offerings of all sizes are sufficient for current needs. Trade activity is moderate. In the parts complex, supplies of wings and most dark meat cuts are moderate for current needs; bone-in breasts are readily available for the generally sluggish demand. Thighs and thigh meat are heavy; boneless skinless breast and tenders are moderate to mostly heavy.

**WESTERN BROILER/FRYER** The Los Angeles preliminary majority is 96 cent, unchanged from last Monday's final. The market on whole fryers is steady and WOGs steady to weak with over 3 lb. sizes weakest. Offerings light to moderate with over 3 lb. sizes the most available. Retail demand moderate to instances good with improvement noted for the weekend. Foodservice demand light to moderate. Floor stocks moderate. Weights adequate. The market on wings is steady with balance of white meat prices steady to lower for next week. Some buyers were finding less discounting on tenderloins towards the end of the week. The market on dark items is steady to lower for next week's shipments, however some are finding fewer discounted loads of leg quarters at the end of the week. Demand light to moderate, instances good with interest into retail channels. Offerings of wings light to moderate with the balance of white items moderate to heavy. Offerings of dark items are moderate to heavy. Movement light to good, mostly moderate.

**SOUTHERN BROILER/FRYER** Prices for whole broiler/fryers are steady. Offerings of all sizes are moderate for trade needs. Demand entering the weekend is moderate. Market activity is mostly moderate. In the parts structure, movement is light for late week business. Prices are steady to weak for breast items and dark meat items. Wings are steady to at times firm. Supplies of wings are moderate, moderate to heavy for bone-in breast, thigh meat, tenders and b/s breast. Market activity for parts is light. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at mixed, but mostly desirable weights.

**DELMARVA BROILER/FRYERS** Less-than-trucklot asking prices are unchanged at 76 to 85 cents, with a steady trending undertone. Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds is light to moderate entering the weekend. Offerings are sufficient to handle current trade needs. Live supplies are moderate; weights are mixed, but noted as mostly desirable. Processing schedules are moderately heavy. Market activity ranged slow to moderate. In the parts complex, wings and most dark meat cuts are moderate. The balance of parts ranged moderate to heavy.

Broiler/Fryer current negotiated prices for immediate delivery includes mostly multiple-drop shipments of branded and wing tagged to New York City from Delmarva.

**Northeast Broiler Parts** Prices are trending steady to instances firm for wings; steady for most dark meat cuts and weak to lower for bone-in breast, thighs and thigh meat. Trucklot buying activity improved slightly under normal weekend demand but still noted as light overall. Offerings are moderate for wings; readily available for bone-in breasts and thigh meat. Tenders and boneless skinless breast are moderate to mostly heavy and slow to clear. Movement is slow to moderate.
