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NATIONAL BROILER

Whole broiler/fryer prices are steady in the West, about steady to weak in the East and weak in the Midwest. Retail and food service demand cover the full range but is mostly light as dealers assess market conditions entering the week. Offerings are light to at times heavy, mostly moderate for early week business. Floor stocks are balanced to short. Market activity is slow to moderate. In the parts structure, movement is light to good, mostly moderate following the weekend. Prices are trending firm to higher for wings, mostly firm for breast items and steady for the balance of parts. Supplies of wings are in close balance with premiums noted; breast items are light to moderate and moving well. Other items are at least sufficient. Market activity is slow to active. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at desirable weights.
