Prices are trending steady to weak in the East and Midwest, generally steady in the West. Retail and food service demand is light to moderate following the weekend as inclement weather remains in parts of the Northeast. Offerings are light to heavy, mostly moderate for current trade needs. Floor stocks are balanced. Market activity is slow to moderate. In the parts structure, movement is light to moderate approaching end of the month and Super bowl weekend. Prices are trending steady to firm for breast items and wings, and mostly steady for the balance of items. Supplies are light to moderate with wings and bone-in breast in the best position. Market activity is slow to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate; weights are mixed, but noted as mostly desirable.
