NATIONAL EGG MARKET AT-A-GLANCE

Prices in New York are 2 cents lower on Extra Large and Large, unchanged on Medium. Regional prices are steady. The undertone continues weak. Asking prices for next week's deliveries are trending lower. Current supplies and offerings are moderate to heavy for trade requirements. Demand is light to moderate, while ranging light to good in the Northeast region due to forecasted winter storms. Market activity is slow to at times moderate. Offerings for breaking stock are moderate to heavy; demand is light. Spent hen offerings are at least sufficient for the mostly light to moderate demand.

Supplies are adequate for current trading purposes. Demand is light to occasionally moderate. Inquiries increase but buyers are cautious as they wait for markets to adjust. Market activity is slow to instances moderate.
