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NATIONAL EGG MARKET AT-A-GLANCE

New York and regional prices are steady with a barely steady undertone. Asking prices for next week's deliveries are trending lower on all sizes. Offerings and supplies are moderate to heavy for immediate trade needs. Demand into all channels is light to moderate while food service demand is fairly good in the Midwest and West Coast. Market activity is slow. Breaking stock offerings are moderate to heavy; breaking schedules are normal to instances reduced. Spent hen offerings are at least sufficient with normal processing schedules.

Liquid whole egg and white prices are steady to higher with yolk steady. The undertone is at least steady for all liquid products. Demand is good for whole egg and whites and moderate to good for yolk. Offerings are light for whole egg and whites and light to moderate for yolk. Most operators were working to fulfill contractual commitments in all product sectors and reported that very few additional loads of liquid egg products were available. Market activity is moderate to active.

Many suppliers were limiting orders of frozen products as current inventories are short of needs. Market activity is moderate to active.
