## NATIONAL BROILER MARKET AT-A-GLANCE

Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending steady to weak entering the weekend. Offerings of all sizes are at least adequate to heavy with limited movement. Retail and food service demand is light to moderate with trading usually limited to regular commitments. Floor stocks are balanced to short. Market activity is slow to moderate. In the parts structure, movement is light to moderate. Prices are steady to firm for wings and tenders, steady to weak for dark meat items, and weak to lower for boneless skinless and bone-in breasts. Supplies are light for wings, light to moderate for tenders, moderate to heavy for breast items, and available for dark meat cuts. Market activity for parts is slow to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at mixed but mostly desirable weights.

The Georgia f.o.b. dock quoted price on broilers/fryers for this week's trading is 105.50 cents based on ice-packed USDA grade "A" sized 2 1/2 to 3 pound birds.

**NORTHEAST BROILER PARTS** Prices are trending firm to higher for wings; weak to lower for breast cuts and generally steady for the balance of items. Trucklot buying activity increased slightly entering the weekend but was noted as no better than moderate overall as dealers continued to keep floor stocks in close balance with immediate needs. Offering of wings are light and clearing well; breast cuts are available and competitively priced. Tenders and most dark meat cuts are at least sufficient for current needs. Movement is slow to moderate.

Retail feature activity is light entering the weekend with majority of interest being in the Southeast region. Finished product supplies are mostly moderate. Market activity is slow to moderate.
