Market News

NATIONAL BROILER MARKET AT-A-GLANCE

Whole broiler/fryer prices are weak to lower in the East, steady to weak in the West, and weak in the Midwest. Offerings are light to available for current trade needs. Retail demand is light to moderate. Food service demand covers the full range but is mostly light to moderate. Floor stocks are closely balanced. Market activity is slow to moderate. In the parts structure, movement improved slightly entering the weekend but is still noted as light to moderate overall. Prices are firm to higher for wings, steady to weak for the balance of items. Offerings of wings are light and moving well. The balance of parts offerings are light to moderate with thighs and thigh meat in the best position. Market activity for parts is slow to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at mixed but mostly desirable weights.

NORTHEAST BROILER/FRYER PARTS - Prices are trending firm to higher for wings; firm for thigh meat and steady to at least steady for tenders. Bone-in breast are weak to lower. Trucklot buying activity improved slightly entering the weekend but still noted as light to moderate overall. Offering of wings are light with good movement; tenders and most dark meat items are light to moderate and clearing satisfactorily with thighs and thigh meat in the best balance. Breast cuts are moderate to heavy with bone-in breasts in the longest position. Movement is slow to moderate.

Weekly broiler-fryer slaughter under federal inspection for the week ending 13-Jul-13 is estimated to be 159,058,000 head up 15.04 percent from a week ago, and up 1.77 percent from a year ago. (Last week 138,266,000, last year 156,299,000)

LIVE SPENT HEAVY FOWL

Prices are trending steady. Supplies are light for the mostly moderate demand. Processing schedules returned to normal following the Fourth-of-July holiday. Retail feature activity is light to moderate entering the weekend with the majority of interest being in the Southeast region. Finished product supplies are adequate. Market activity is slow to moderate.

LIVE SPENT LIGHT FOWL

Prices are trending steady for the light to moderate demand. Offerings of light type hens are sufficient for current needs. Processing schedules returned to normal following the holiday. Movement of finished product sales are adequate. Market activity is slow to moderate. The majority price for removal costs remains unchanged at 0-7 cents per head. Retail activity is moderate to good.
