NATIONAL BROILER MARKET-AT-A-GLANCE

Whole broiler/fryer prices are steady to firm in the West, firm in the Midwest and steady in the East. Offerings are light to moderate for current trade needs. Retail and food service demand is light to moderate for mid-week business. Floor stocks are balance. Market activity cover the full range but is mostly moderate. In the parts structure, movement is light to moderate. Prices for breast cuts and tenders are weak to lower, wings are steady to weak and steady for the balance of parts. Offerings of breast cuts are increasing in availability. Wings continued to see improving seasonal interest; tenders and most dark meat items are moderate for current needs. Movement is slow to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at mixed but mostly desirable weights

GEORGIA F.O.B. DOCK The quoted price on broilers/fryers for next week's trading is unchanged at 106.25 cents based on full truck load lots of ice-packed USDA grade "A" sized 2 1/2 to 3 pound birds. This compares to 95.75 cents last year on September 12, 2012.

(2)The estimated number of broiler-fryers available for slaughter the week ending 14-Sep-13 is 155.4 million head compared to 156.8 million head slaughtered the same week last year. The estimated U.S. slaughter this week is 158.0 million head or 2.6 million more than estimated available. For the week of 21-Sep-13 the estimated available is 156.7 million head.

WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING - Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 19-Oct-13 is estimated at 152.8 million head. This compares to 152.1 million head the previous week and to 151.8 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 156.9 million head and the national weighted average price was 83.13 cents per pound.

Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the 19 State Total Up 5 Percent

Commercial hatcheries in the 19 State weekly program set 195 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 7, 2013. This was up 5 percent from the eggs set the corresponding week a year earlier. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week was 84 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the 19 State Total Up 3 Percent

Broiler growers in the 19 State weekly program placed 165 million chicks for meat production during the week ending September 7, 2013. Placements were up 3 percent from the comparable week a year earlier. Cumulative placements from December 30, 2012 through September 7, 2013 for the 19 State total were 5.95 billion, up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.
