## Canada

On November 1, 2013 Canada published Notice No. 848 to importers concerning imports of eggs and egg products. On November 8, 2013 Notice 851 on supplemental imports was released. Imports of eggs and egg products into Canada are subject to import controls under Canada's Export and Import Permits Act (EIPA). Accordingly, an import permit is required for shipments of eggs and egg products to enter Canada. Import permits for shipments of eggs and egg products destined to the Canadian market are issued to allocation holders under Canada's tariff rate quota (TRQ) for eggs and egg products, which is administered by Foreign Affairs, Trade, and Development Canada (DFATD).

The access quantity for eggs and egg products TRQ is 21,370,000 dozen or 2.988% of the previous year's domestic production as determined by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada, whichever is greater. The allocation period for the eggs and egg products TRQ extends from January 1 to December 31, inclusive. The Minister may, at his discretion, authorize the importation of quantities of eggs and egg products in excess of the import access quantity, particularly if he judges that the importation of these products is required to serve overall Canadian market needs.





Prices of MSC are trending steady to firm. Demand into domestic and export channels is mostly moderate. Supplies are light to moderate. Schedules are mostly normal going into the Memorial Day holiday weekend. Excess MSC and frames are mostly in good shape and clearing with asking prices out front slightly higher. Finished product movement is typical for the time of year as industry prepares to kick off the summer season. Industry continues to closely monitor any and all developments in the marketplace. Market activity is moderate to active. Supplies of raw materials are light to moderate. Frame prices are steady to firm with trading levels between 14.00-16.25 cents FOB.



The market on bulk parts was steady with a firm undertone on frozen tom drums and tom two joint wings. Demand and offerings was light to moderate. The market on white meat and white trims is unchanged at steady to firm. Demand moderate to good. Offerings light. High meat market is steady. Demand and offerings light to moderate. Trading for parts was slow. For domestic: frozen tails 58 cents, fresh tails 56 cents, fresh wing meat 130 cents, fresh full cut wings 73 cents, fresh scapula 183-187 cents, fresh MST pet food 47 cents and drumettes 70 cents delivered. For export: fresh tom drums 89 cents and fresh thigh meat 170 cents delivered to the Border.
