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NATIONAL BROILER MARKET-AT-A-GLANCE

Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending steady in the East and Midwest, steady to weak in the West. Offerings of all sizes are light to available for current trade needs. Retail demand is light to good, mostly moderate entering the weekend. Food service demand is light to moderate. Floor stocks are balance to short as buyers are cautious limiting orders to immediate needs. Market activity is slow to moderate. In the parts structure, movement improved slightly under normal weekend demand but is noted as moderate overall. Prices are steady to firm for wings, drums, thighs and thigh meat. The balance of items were mostly steady. Offerings of wings and most dark meat cuts are light and well cleared; breast cut are light to moderate. Market activity for parts is slow to mostly moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at mixed but mostly desirable weights.

Offerings of drums, wings, thighs and thigh meat are light and well cleared; breast cuts and other dark meat items are light to moderate for current needs. Movement is moderate.

Prices are trending generally steady for the light demand. Offerings of light type hens are sufficient for current needs. Processing schedules are normal to less than normal. Movement of finished product sales is moderate. Market activity is moderate. The majority price for removal costs remains unchanged at 0-7 cents per head.
