Frozen whole egg prices are steady to lower with whites steady to higher and sugared and salted yolk prices steady. Trade sentiment is steady to barely steady for whole egg, steady to higher for whites and steady for frozen yolk products. Demand is moderate to fairly good for whole egg, good to very good for whites and moderate for sugared and salted yolk. Offerings are light to moderate for whole egg, light for whites and moderate to slightly more available for yolk. Supplies are light to moderate for whole egg, light to short of needs for whites and light to mostly moderate for sugared and salted yolk. Market activity is moderate to active.

Movement of finished product sales is light to moderate. Market activity is moderate. The majority price for removal costs remains unchanged at 0-7 cents per head. Feature activity is moderate with most interest being in the Northeast region.
