NATIONAL BROILER MARKET-AT-A-GLANCE

Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending generally steady. Offerings of all sizes are light to instances heavy, mostly light to moderate for current trade needs. Retail demand is light to instances good, mostly moderate entering the weekend. Food service demand is light to moderate. Floor stocks are balance to short as buyers continue to purchase hand to mouth. Market activity is slow to mostly moderate. In the parts structure, movement improved slightly under normal weekend demand but is noted as moderate overall. Prices are steady to mostly firm for wings; steady to firm for dark meat items and steady for breast cuts. Offerings of wings are light and clearing well. Breast cuts and dark meat items are light to moderate. Market activity for parts is slow to mostly moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at mixed but mostly desirable weights.

Trucklot buying activity improved slightly under normal weekend demand but is still noted as moderate overall. Offerings of wings are light and clearing satisfactory; breast cuts and dark meat items are light to moderate with drums, thighs and thigh meat in the best balance. Movement is moderate.

Broiler-fryer slaughter under federal inspection for 20-Jun-14 and 21-Jun-14 is estimated to be 31,815,000 head down 1.18 percent from a week ago and up 6.07 percent from a year ago. (Last week 32,195,000, last year 29,994,000)

Weekly broiler-fryer slaughter under federal inspection for the week ending 21-Jun-14 is estimated to be 157,250,000 head up 0.45 percent from a week ago, and up 0.98 percent from a year ago. (Last week 156,540,000, last year 155,719,000)

LIVE SPENT HEAVY FOWL

Prices are trending at least steady. Supplies are sufficient for the moderate demand. Processing schedules are normal. Finished product supplies are moderate. Market activity is moderate. Retail feature activity is light with the bulk of interest being in the South Central region.

LIVE SPENT LIGHT FOWL

Prices are trending generally steady for the light demand. Offerings of light type hens are fully sufficient for current needs. Processing schedules are increased slightly. Movement of finished product sales is light to moderate. Market activity is moderate. The majority price for removal costs remains unchanged at 0-7 cents per head. Feature activity is moderate with most interest being in the Northeast regions.
