Regional prices are 3 cents lower on Jumbo, 6 to 10 cents lower on Extra Large and Large, 7 to 12 cents lower on Medium. New York prices are unchanged. The undertone is steady to barely steady. Current offerings and supplies are mixed, mostly moderate while moderate to instances heavy in the South Central region. Retail demand is light to moderate. Food service demand is light to generally moderate. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock offerings are light to moderate and supplies are heavy; demand is light. Spent hen offerings are sufficient for the light demand.
