NATIONAL BROILER MARKET-AT-A-GLANCE

Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending steady to firm in the West steady elsewhere. Offerings are mixed ranging light to available for current trade needs. Retail and food service demand is light to good, mostly moderate entering the weekend. Floor stocks are mixed. Market activity is slow to mostly moderate. In the parts structure, movement improved slightly under normal weekend demand but is noted as light to moderate overall. Prices are steady to firm for wings, thighs and thigh meat with the balance of parts generally steady. Offerings of dark meat items are light to moderate with fairly good movement; other items are generally sufficient for current needs with many dealers continuing to have trouble securing trucks for shipping. Market activity for parts is slow to mostly moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at mixed but mostly desirable weights.

Broiler-fryer slaughter under federal inspection for 27-Jun-14 and 28-Jun-14 is estimated to be 36,737,000 head up 15.73 percent from a week ago and down 0.29 percent from a year ago. (Last week 31,744,000, last year 36,843,000)

Weekly broiler-fryer slaughter under federal inspection for the week ending 28-Jun-14 is estimated to be 162,260,000 head up 3.64 percent from a week ago, and up 0.47 percent from a year ago. (Last week 156,563,000, last year 161,497,000)

LIVE SPENT HEAVY FOWL

Prices are trending at least steady. Supplies are at least sufficient for the mostly moderate demand. Processing schedules increased slightly. Finished product supplies are moderate. Market activity is moderate. Retail feature activity is moderate with the bulk of interest being in the Northeast and Southeast regions.

LIVE SPENT LIGHT FOWL

Prices are trending generally steady for the light to moderate demand. Offerings of light type hens are sufficient for current needs. Processing schedules are mostly normal. Movement of finished product sales is light to moderate. Market activity is moderate. The majority price for removal costs remains unchanged at 0-7 cents per head. Feature activity is light with most activity being in the Southeast region.
