New York and regional prices are steady, while Southeast regional prices are mixed on larger sizes, steady to 5 cents lower on Mediums. The undertone is steady to higher. Offerings are light to moderate, noted as held with confidence in the South Central region. Supplies are generally moderate, however ranging light to fully sufficient in the Western region. Retail and distributive demand in in full range, mostly moderate to fairly good. Market activity is moderate to at times slow. Breaking stock offerings are light to moderate for the light demand. Light type fowl offerings are adequate; processing schedules are normal.
