Prices continue to trend steady at best for the light to moderate demand. Offerings of light type hens are sufficient for current needs. Processing schedules were reduced slightly. Movement of finished product sales are moderate. Market activity is slow to moderate. The majority price for removal costs continued unchanged at 0-7 cents per head. Retail features are light with best interest being in the Southeast.
