Ads in the South Central and hotter temperatures moving out of the West Coast area causes variations in demand, but overall demand ranges light to fairly good. Market activity is slow to active, mostly moderate. Breaking stock offerings are light for the moderate to fairly good demand. Light type hen offerings are moderate for normal processing schedules.
