**NATIONAL BROILER MARKET-AT-A-GLANCE**

Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending steady to firm in the West, steady elsewhere. Offerings are light to moderate. Retail demand cover the full range but is mostly moderate to good. Food service demand is moderate to good entering the weekend. Floor stocks are generally balanced. Market activity is moderate. In the parts structure, movement is light to moderate. Prices are steady to higher for wings and boneless skinless breast; weak to lower for tenders and steady to weak for dark meat items. Offerings of wings and boneless skinless breast are in close balance with premiums noted. Tenders are readily available with discounting noted. Dark meat items are moderate to heavy for current trade needs. Market activity for parts is slow to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at mixed but mostly desirable weights.

**NORTHEAST BROILER PARTS** Prices are firm to higher for wings and boneless skinless breast; weak for tenders and about steady for dark meat cuts. Trucklot buying activity increased slightly as dealers kept floor stocks in close balance with current needs. Offerings of boneless skinless breasts and wings are in close balance and clearing well with premiums noted. Tenders are fully adequate to ample with some discounting noted, however, supplies are less burdensome when compared to earlier in the week. Dark meat items are moderate to heavy for current needs. Livers and gizzards are seeing more seasonal interest. Movement is slow to moderate.

Finished product supplies are moderate for current needs. Market activity is slow to moderate with retail feature activity moderate, with the bulk of interest being in the Southeast region.
