New York prices are up 2 cents on larger sizes, unchanged on Medium. Regional prices are steady. The undertone is steady to higher. Asking prices for next week's deliveries are trending higher on larger sizes, steady on smaller sizes. Retail and distributive demand is in a full range, generally moderate. Offerings are light to moderate and held with confidence in Midwest and Northeast regions. Supplies are light to moderate, however moderate to instances heavy in the Northeast. Market activity is moderate, while moderate to active in the Midwest. Breaking stock offerings are light to moderate for the moderate demand. Light type hen offerings are light to moderate; demand is light to moderate.

Frozen white prices are steady to lower with the balance of frozen prices steady. Trade sentiment is lower for whites and steady on the remainder of frozen products. Demand is fairly good to good for whole egg, light to moderate for whites and good for frozen yolk products. Offerings are moderate for all frozen egg products. Supplies are light to moderate for whole egg, moderate to instances heavy for whites and light to usually moderate for frozen sugared and salted yolk. Market activity is moderate.
