DOMESTIC MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

The fresh and frozen 8-16 lb. hen and 16-24 lb. tom market is firm for prompt deliveries. Frozen Thanksgiving fill-in demand light to moderate. Frozen 8-16 lb. hen and 16-24 lb. tom offerings light. Frozen Grade A basted equivalent processor offering prices on a national basis for hens 117.00-124.00 cents fob and 16-24 lb. toms 117.00-124.00 cents fob for current deliveries. No current trading was reported.

The market on bulk parts was steady. Demand and offerings was light to moderate. White meat and white trims market is steady. Demand was light to moderate. Offerings mixed. Thigh meat market is steady. Demand was mixed. Offerings light to moderate. Mechanically separated turkey market steady. Demand light. Offerings moderate. Trading for parts slow.

EXPORT MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

The market is steady. Demand and offerings light to moderate. Trading was seasonally slow.

For export: fresh tom drums 102 cents delivered to Border.
