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NATIONAL EGG MARKET AT-A-GLANCE

Regional Prices are 28 cents higher on Jumbo, up 7.5 to 31 cents on Extra Large, up 5.5 to 29 cents on Large, Medium steady to 2 cents higher, Small up 2 cents. New York prices are 8 cents higher on Extra Large and Large, up 2 cents on Medium. The undertone is higher on all sizes. Retail and food service demand range moderate to instances very good. Offerings are very light to light and held with increased confidence in most regions. Supplies are light to moderate for current trade requirements. Market activity is moderate to generally active. Breaking stock supplies are light to moderate for mixed, mostly full-time breaking schedules. Light type fowl offerings are light to sufficient; demand is moderate.
