NATIONAL BROILER MARKET-AT-A-GLANCE

Whole broiler/fryer prices are steady to firm in the West, at least steady to steady in the East, and steady in the Midwest. Offerings are light to moderate entering the holiday weekend with some dealers continuing to have trouble securing trucks for shipment. Retail and food service demand is light to good, mostly light to moderate for current trade needs. Floor stocks are mixed. Market activity is slow to moderate. In the parts structure, movement was light to fair for mid-week business. Prices are steady to firm for wings, steady for boneless skinless breast and tenders. Other items are no better than steady. Offerings of wings are in very good balance and moving well; tenders and boneless skinless breast are light to moderate. Dark meat items are moderate to heavy with drums noted as slightly more available. Market activity for parts is seasonally slow to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at mixed but mostly desirable weights.

GEORGIA F.O.B. DOCK The Georgia f.o.b. dock quoted price on broilers/fryers for next week's trading remains unchanged at 113.75 cents based on full truck load lots of ice-packed USDA grade "A" sized 2 1/2 to 3 pound birds. This compares to 104.25 cents last year on December 26, 2013.

WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING – Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 31-Jan-15 is estimated at 157.4 million head. This compares to 156.9 million head the previous week and to 156.2 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 158.0 million head and the national weighted average price was 93.94 cents per pound.

Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 2 Percent

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 215 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 20, 2014, up 2 percent from a year ago. Hatcheries in the 19 State weekly program set 207 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 20, 2014, up 2 percent from the year earlier. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 83 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 3 Percent

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 177 million chicks for meat production during the week ending December 20, 2014, up 3 percent from a year ago. Broiler growers in the 19 State weekly program placed 171 million chicks for meat production during the week ending December 20, 2014, up 3 percent from the year earlier. Cumulative placements from December 29, 2013 through December 20, 2014 for the United States were 8.76 billion. Cumulative placements were up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.


