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NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional prices are 2 to 12.5 cents higher on Extra Large, 3 to 14 cents higher on Large and 2 to 6.5 cents higher on Medium. California prices are 95 cents lower on Jumbo, 85 cents lower on Extra Large, 82 cents lower on Large and 75 cents lower on Medium and Small. New York prices are steady. The undertone is steady to lower. Offerings are moderate to heavy. Supplies are in a full range of light to heavy, heavier in California. Demand into all channels is light to fairly good, mostly moderate. Market activity is moderate to slow. Breaking stock supplies are moderate for a moderate demand. Light type hen offerings are moderate for mostly normal processing schedules.

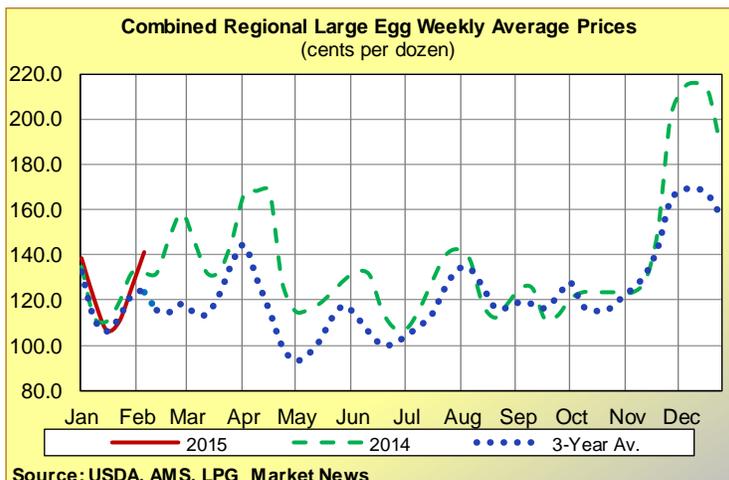

Prices are higher for whole egg, steady to higher for yolk, and to few to report for whites. Animal care certified whole egg prices 73 cents FOB. The undertone is steady to mostly higher for whole egg and yolk, steady to lower whites. Demand is light to moderate for whole egg, light for whites and moderate to fairly good for yolk. Offerings are light to moderate on all liquid egg products. Market activity remains slow to moderate.

Non-pasteurized in trucklots; current trading for delivery within 14 days.

Frozen Eggs

Frozen whole egg prices are higher, lower for whites, sugared and salted yolk prices steady to lower. Trade sentiment is steady to higher for whole egg, steady to lower for whites and higher for frozen yolk products. Offerings are light to moderate for whole egg and light for the balance of frozen products. Demand is moderate to fairly good for whole egg, mostly moderate for whites and fairly good for frozen yolk products. Supplies are moderate to instances heavy for whole egg, moderate for whites and light for frozen sugared and salted yolk. Market activity is moderate.

Dried egg prices are lower on whole, steady on yolk, irregular on albumen and steady to lower on blends. The undertone is lower on albumen, steady on the balance of dried egg products. Offerings are light on yolk, moderate on whole, moderate to heavy on albumen. Demand is mixed, ranging light to fairly good with most interest on LTL trading. Current supplies are light on yolk, moderate to heavy on whole and albumen. Market activity is moderate.
