



EGG MARKET NEWS REPORT

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NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional prices are 5 to 18 cents lower for Extra Large, down 1 to 16 cents for Large, 2.5 to 19 cents lower for Medium. California prices are 2 cents higher on Extra Large and Large, steady on the balance of the sizes. The undertone is steady to higher in California, steady in the remaining areas. Offerings are light to mostly moderate. Demand is light to moderate, with retail demand reporting improvement in the South Central and Southeast regions and food service demand moderate to fairly good in California. Current supplies are light to usually moderate for trading purposes. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock floor stocks are moderate to heavy for normal to over-time breaking schedules. Light type hen offerings are light to adequate, demand is moderate.



Prices are trending steady for the moderate demand. Offerings of light type hens are light to moderate for current needs. Processing schedules were reduced. Movement of finished product are sufficient. Market activity is slow to moderate. The majority price for removal costs remained unchanged at 0-7 cents per head. Feature activity was very light.
