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NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional prices are steady to 2 cents lower on Extra Large and Large, steady to 4 cents lower on Medium. California prices are 2 cents higher on Jumbo, Extra Large and Large, steady on Medium and Small. New York prices are steady. The undertone is steady. Current supplies are in a full range of light to instances heavy, mostly moderate. Offerings are light to moderate. Demand ranges light to fairly good, with improvement noted on retail demand. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock supplies are moderate for normal breaking schedules. Light hen supplies are sufficient for the light to moderate demand.

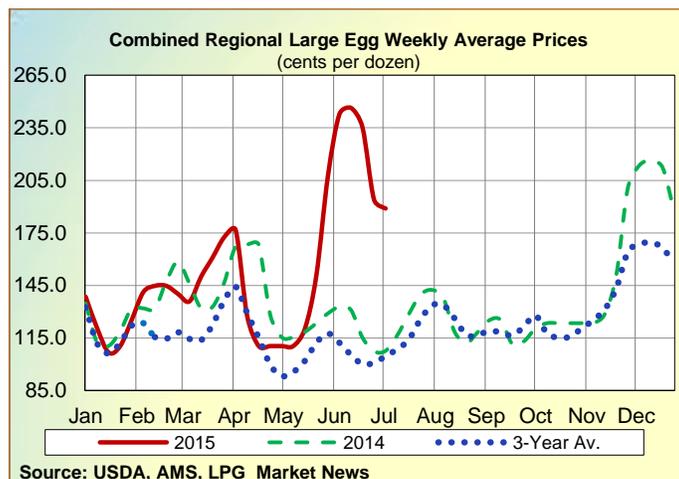

Liquid Eggs
Liquid whole egg prices are steady to lower with whites and yolk continuing too few to report. Trade sentiment is steady to higher on all liquid egg products. Offerings of liquid whole egg are moderate to more available as the 4th of July holiday sees a number of further processors reducing schedules at the end of this week. Offerings of whites and yolk are light. Demand remains good to very good for all liquid egg products. Market activity is moderate.
Non-pasteurized in trucklots; current trading for delivery within 14 days.

Frozen Eggs
Frozen salted yolk prices are irregular with the balance of frozen prices higher when compared to last week's trading. The undertone remains steady to mostly higher for all frozen egg products. Offerings are very light to short of immediate needs as many processors concentrate on other value added egg products and limit or eliminate frozen egg product offerings. Demand is good to very good. Market activity is moderate.

Demand is good to very good on light to very light offerings. Current supplies are light to very light. Inquiries to acquire dried products continue as processors work to fill regular commitments. Market activity is slow to moderate.

Live Spent Light Fowl

Prices are trending steady for the light to moderate demand. Offerings of light type hens are sufficient for current needs. Processing schedules are reduced slightly. Movement of finished product are moderate. Market activity is slow to moderate. The majority price for removal costs remained unchanged at 0-7 cents per head. Feature activity was very light.

Egg Products

Shell Eggs Broken Down 15 Percent from Last Year

May 2014 contained 22 weekdays (including 1 holiday) and 5 Saturdays. May 2015 contained 21 weekdays (including 1 holiday) and 5 Saturdays.

Shell eggs broken totaled 166 million dozen during May 2015, down 15 percent from May a year ago, and 9 percent below the 182 million broken during the previous month.

During calendar year 2015 through May, shell eggs broken totaled 900 million dozen, up slightly from the comparable period in 2014. To date, cumulative total edible product from eggs broken in 2015 was 1,167 million pounds, down slightly from 2014.
