

According to Nass's Crop progress report, Dry Peas planted in Washington are at 72 percent, Idaho are at 48 percent, Oregon are at 40 percent, Montana are at 43 percent and North Dakota are at 21 percent. Dry Beans planted in Colorado are at 1 percent, Idaho are at 1 percent, Montana are at 11 percent and Washington are at 6 percent. Dry conditions reported in Northwestern states. Dark Red Kidneys, Small Red Beans, and Black Beans are in tight supply.






