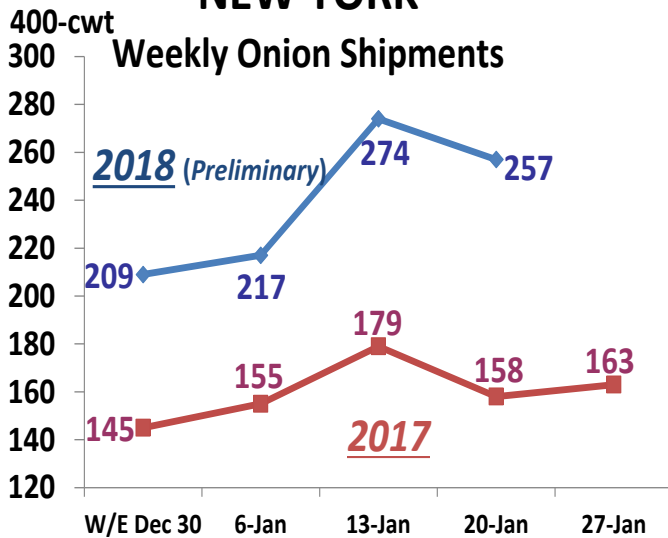
IDAHO & MALHEUR COUNTY, OR 400-cwt Weekly Onion Shipments



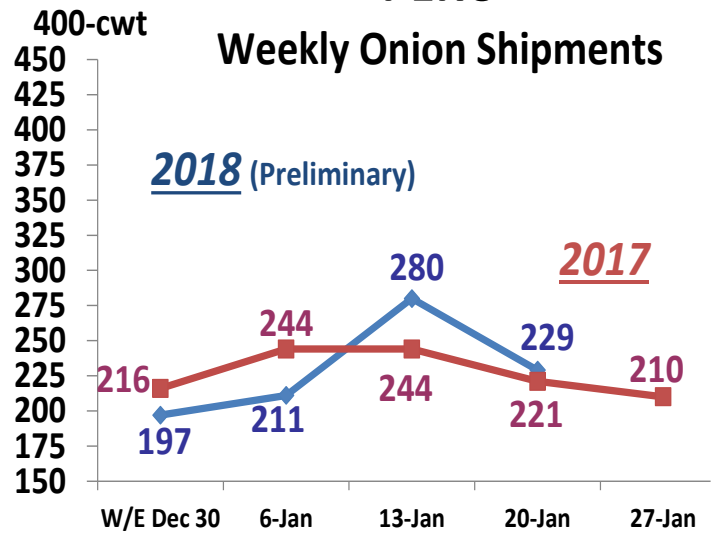
COLUMBIA BASIN, WASHINGTON 400-cwt Weekly Onion Shipments



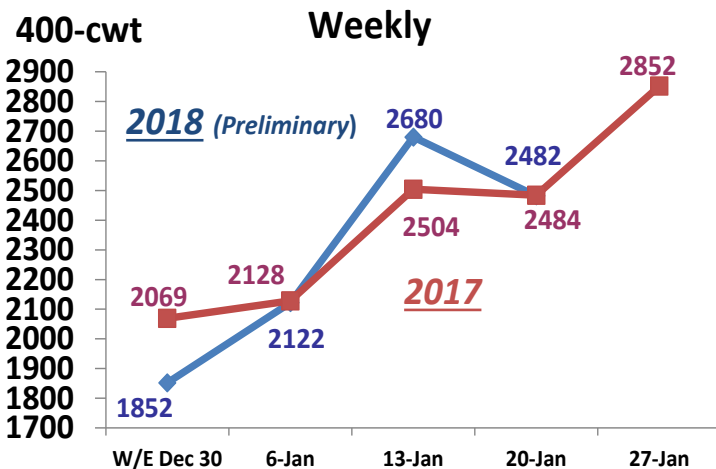

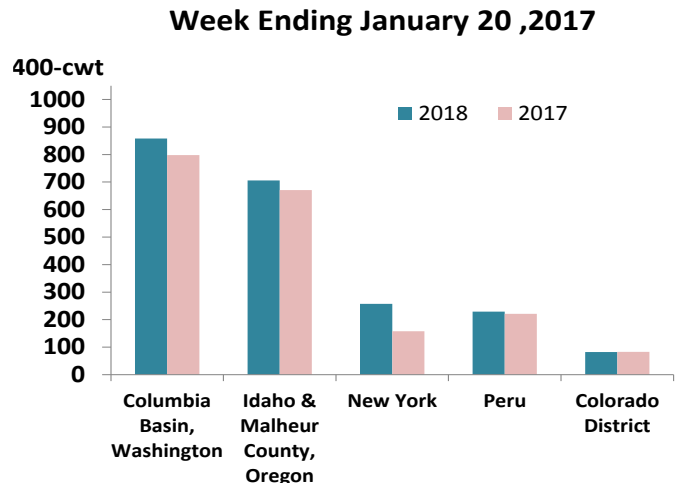

UNITED STATES---Shipments (not including imports) 1519*-1929*-1972---The top shipping states, in order, were Idaho, San Luis Valley Colorado, Wisconsin, Columbia Basin Washington, and Minnesota-North Dakota (Red River Valley). The Market News Service survey of over 30,000 retail stores had 18,618 ads for potatoes last week, which is a 2 percent increase from last weeks ads of 18,818. *revised.
