

Receipts: This Week 49,200 Last Report 34,900 Year Ago 13,200

Compared to last report: Feeder steers and heifers sold steady to 2.00 higher. Single digit temperatures with snow flurries predicted for the weekend and most sales being closed next week prompted sellers to get their cattle to market. Slaughter cows and bulls traded mostly steady to 1.00 higher. Alfalfa prices sold 5.00 to 10.00 higher as freight continued to play a factor when finding quality hay. A weekly comparison of Texas High Plains cash grain markets from last report on Friday, wheat traded 6 to 11 cents higher, corn sold 9 to 11 cents higher and Sorghum traded 16 cents higher. **Report will not be released for the next 2 weeks, while most sales are closed for the holidays, report will resume Monday January 9th, 2017.**
